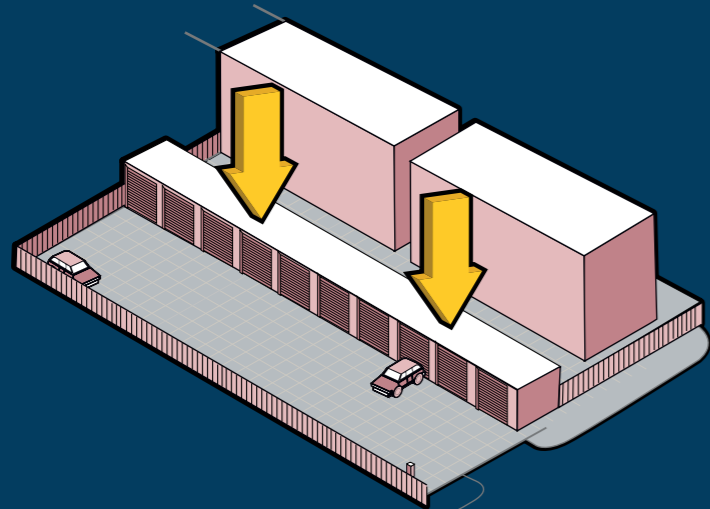

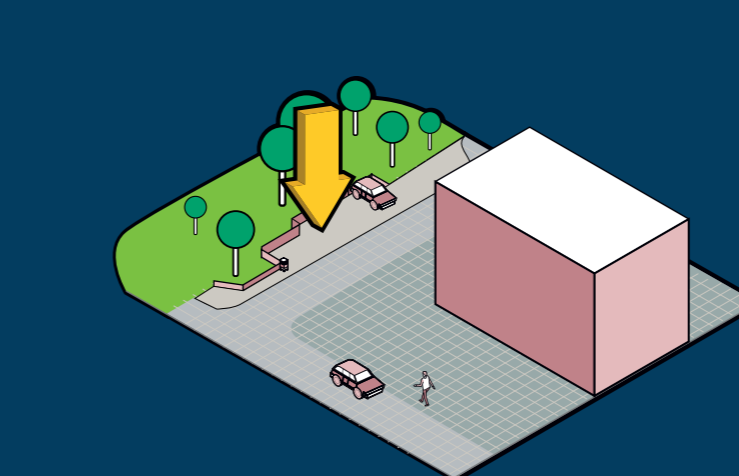
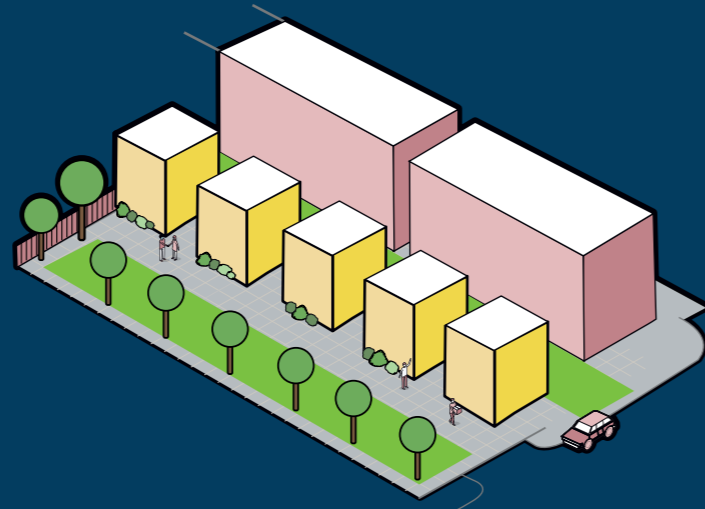
What are small sites?

Small Sites could include:

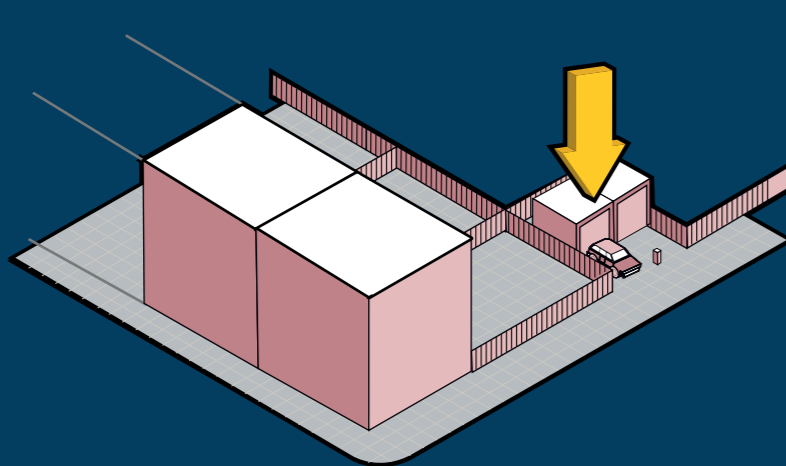
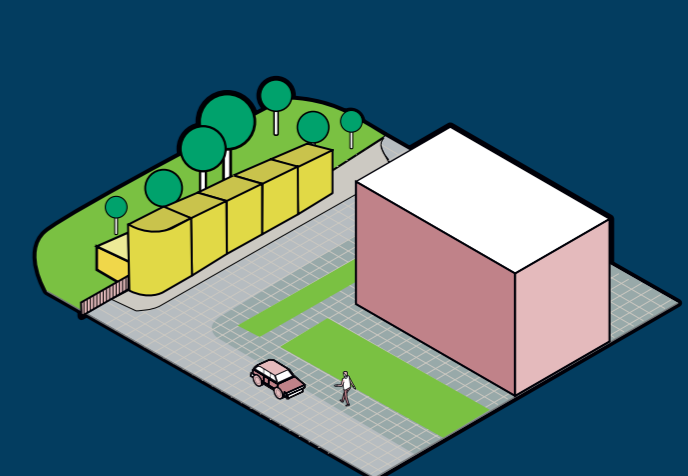
- forgotten parts of your neighbourhood

- unattractive gaps between buildings



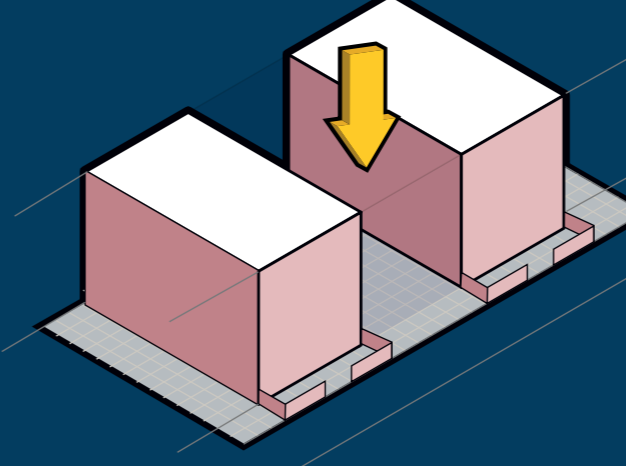
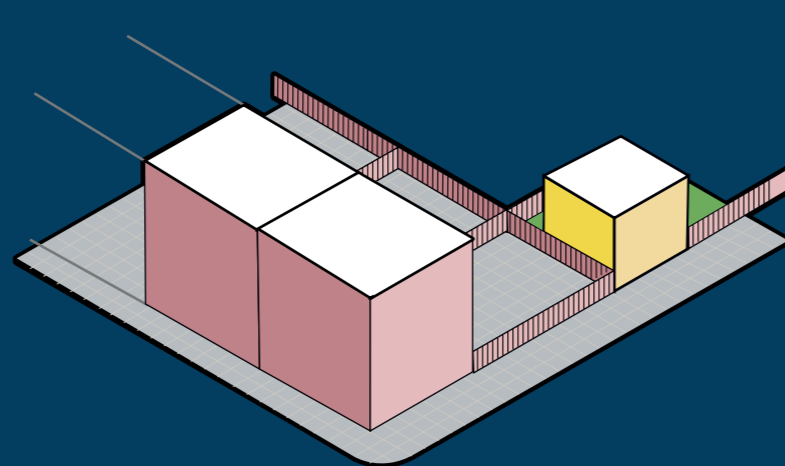
Underused garages



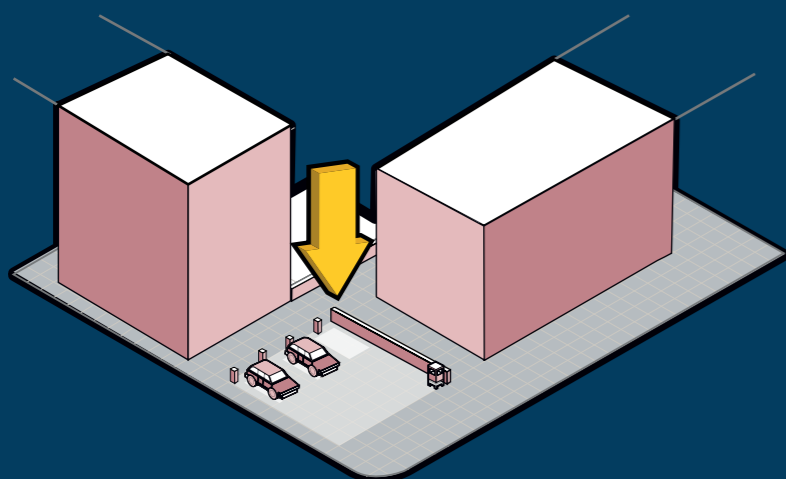
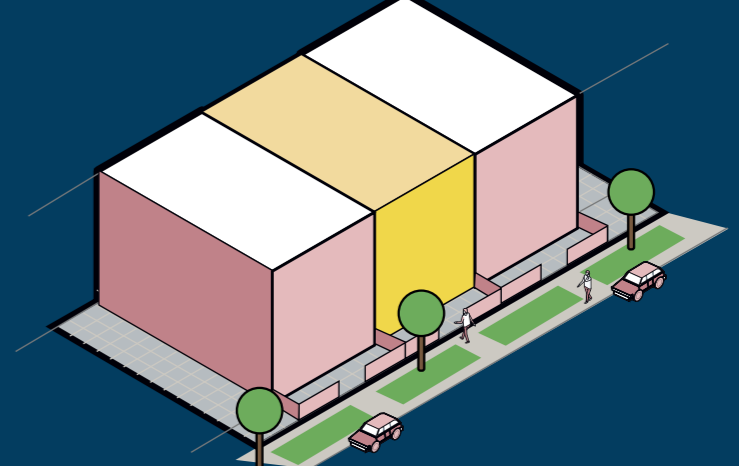
Underused areas of the estates



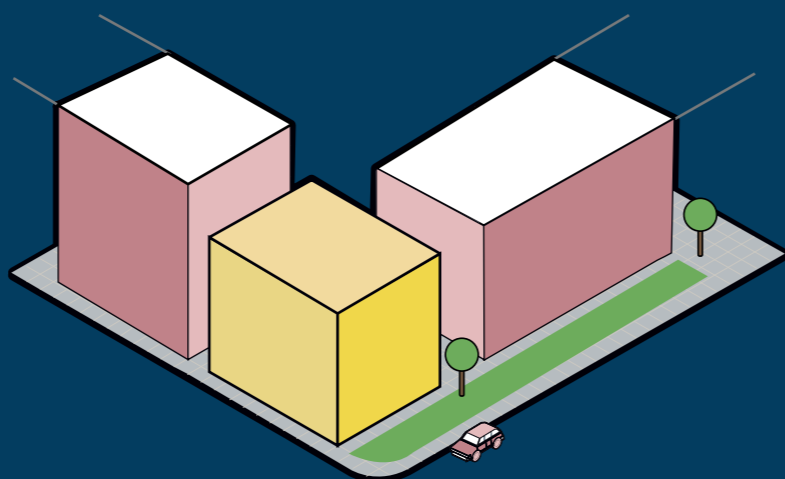
Very small garages

Underused car parks



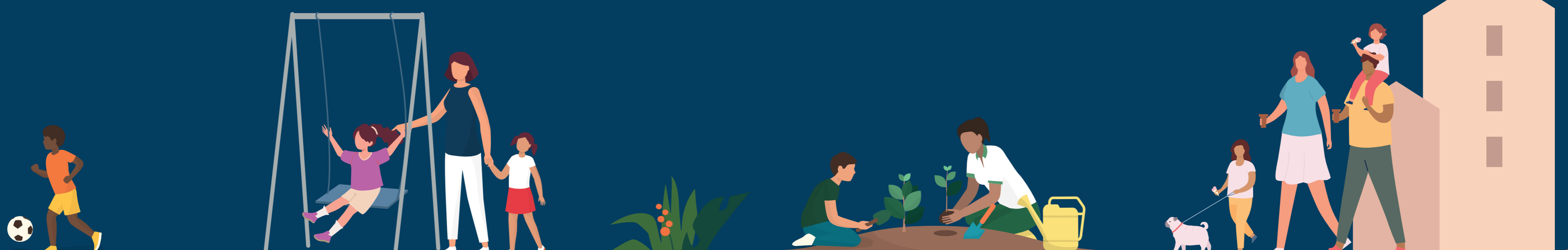
How can we build on small sites?

1 Camden could build new affordable homes directly through its Community Investment Programme.

3 Camden could sell a very small site to a local self builder who could build an individual home for their family.

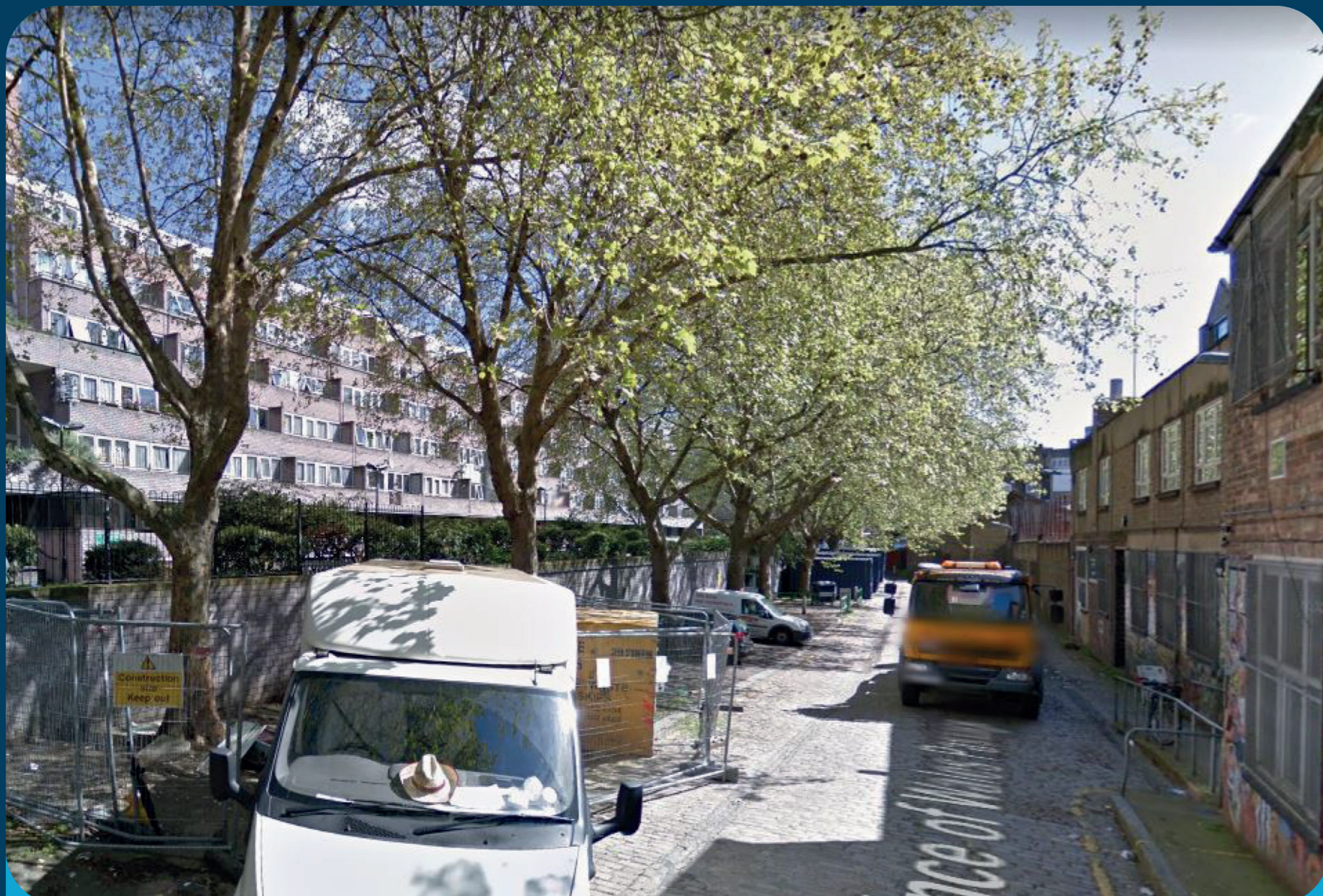
4 Camden can sell a site to a developer to build new homes and Camden will reinvest the money into building more council homes through its Community Investment Programme.
